Minnesota Statutes Section 144G.06 requires the Minnesota Department of Health to develop a “Uniform Consumer Information Guide” (UCIG) data collection format for housing with service establishments defined as “Assisted Living” under Minnesota Statutes Section 144G.02. There are currently 873 registered providers with an estimated capacity of 47,000 residents. A comprehensive tool has been developed over a period of two years by an MDH stakeholders group to identify information elements important to elderly citizens when making expensive health and housing decisions. The guide contains information regarding access and cost for health and other assisted living services that consumers need for decision making.

This project is the result of an interagency agreement between the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Minnesota Board of Aging (MBA). The intent is to leverage the strengths of both governmental bodies to get elderly Minnesota citizens assisted living health and lifestyle information to make the best individual decisions with limited financial assets. The goal is to provide current, accurate, and well presented service availability and cost information about assisted living providers in Minnesota.
